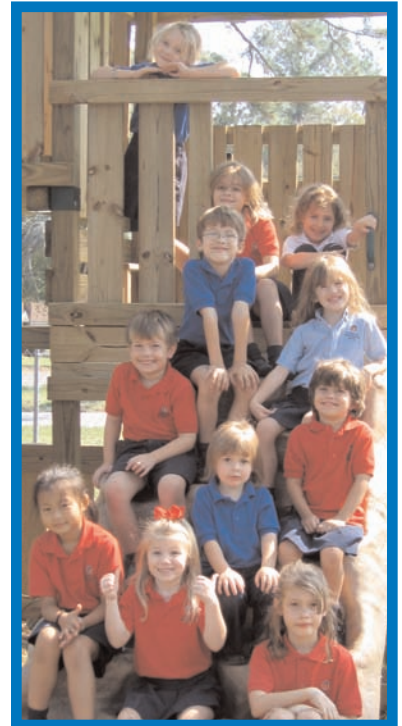

PRE-K

The children are continuing to build Mandarin Chinese language skills. They are quite comfortable with numbers through 100. In English, the kids are working on handwriting skills and reading.

KINDERGARTEN
